

Like you, my heart has been sickened and grieved by the recent Guidepost report released by the Sex Abuse Task Force on Sunday, May 22. In response to repeated appeals for help from victims of abuse at the hands of Southern Baptist ministers, trusted leaders failed to act with compassion and neglected their God-given responsibility to

"search out a matter" (Proverbs 25:2). To make matters worse, leaders are reported to have caused further harm to the survivors of abuse by questioning their integrity, dismissing their concerns, and refusing to assume a leadership role in highlighting and correcting the problems that have now been made public.

I believe we can respond as an association in two ways.





First, we need to renew our pursuit of Jesus as our Lord in every area of our lives.

No recommendation for reform of an institution is going to have any impact on the heart. As pastors and church leaders, when we draw near to Jesus in a genuine and intimate way, He will draw near to us! (James 4:8) Pure lives are a direct result of drawing near to a holy God. Do you want to know Him more fully? You will do whatever is needed to maintain clean hands and a pure heart (Psalm 24:3-4). In coming months, we will be providing opportunities for our pastors to come together to challenge and encourage one another in our individual pursuit of God.

Second, we need to encourage our churches to adopt best practices for preventing abuse and responding to abuse when it happens. Our actions need to be Christlike, defined by scripture, and law-abiding, with every effort made to assure that our churches are spiritually and physically safe environments. We need to be known as healing places... not harmful places. We will help accomplish this through identifying and making available abuse prevention guidelines and training opportunities on an annual basis.

Please pray for our churches and for your pastor. My heart is broken for the dear ones who have been harmed. We can help heal and undo the damage that has been done. The Father has called us to make Him known throughout the Northshore and beyond. As we surrender to His majesty and authority, He will guide us step-by-step through these difficult days to rely on Him more and less on ourselves.
