The annual church profile is a snapshot of church statistics. It provides a knowledgeable look at the growth and potential of each church. Reporting the statistics has several benefits for the church, the association, and the Louisiana Baptist Convention.

- 1. The church can track growth over time.
- 2. The data can be used to help church leadlers plan ministry and outreach strategies.
- 3. The church can share the data when meeting with prospective pastors and church staff.
- 4. The data can be used to help secure loans for building projects.
- 5. The data can be used to assist church planting in reaching people groups.
- 6. The number of messengers your church sends to the LBC Annual meeting is determined by data provided on the ACP.
- 7. The local association and the Louisiana Baptist Convention can use the information to plan strategies and support existing programs as well as to identify areas for church planting.
- 8. The Louisiana Baptist Convention archives the data for the church in case theft, fire or natural disasters destroy church records.

It has been a historic season of unrest and anxiety in our nation. How are you doing? Regardless of what you've been going through, I know what you need – because we all need it. Everyone you know needs it.

Encouragement. In Romans 14:19, Paul writes, "Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another."

I used to have a penny jar at home... not any more. Let me tell you what happened. Day by day I used to empty my pocket change into my penny jar, but as my kids got older, I noticed the level of saved change began going down! While I was adding to the jar regularly, someone else (I will not name names) was taking my contributions away — the result? No more change for emergency Big Mac attacks!

That really captures what Paul is dealing with in Romans 14. God is building a bride for His Son and we are very

much a part of the process. In the church we are called to "edify" or build each other up — not to tear each other down. The way we speak to each other and the way we treat each other adds to what God is doing or detracts from it.

So pretend the church today is like a great, big penny jar for God. Every day He adds to our lives as we read His Word and spend time alone with Him in prayer. With a deep affection, He encourages us, guides us, corrects us — whatever it takes to build us up into a mature, godly lover of Jesus Christ. The level in the penny jar is raised daily as we walk with Him.

And as we come to interact with other members of His family, He intends that the building continue. But does it? Or do we take away from what God is doing in others? In every conversation I have a decision to make: will I add to this person's life or not? Worse yet: am I going to pilfer what God has stored up in this person? Sound like an odd concept? Consider the

range of decisions we can consciously make when we encounter a brother or sister in Christ. Some quick examples...

In general conversation: am I going to speak about my needs or focus on encouraging someone else? When I hear of a brother's failure or weakness: am I going to spread damaging information about him or be graciously silent?

When we disagree: am I going to argue my position or listen to your heart?

Every member of my family needs my contribution to his or her life. God made us that way!

Let's stop pilfering from the "penny jar of God" in the hearts of others. Let's start emptying pockets of kindness into each other's lives. Let's do it today!
