# SLU BCM Update

This semester has been an amazing time of growth, both spiritually and numerically. We've seen students coming to know the Lord with regularity over the past several weeks as BCM students are getting out onto campus and sharing the gospel with their peers. This has been an emphasis this semester.

Another emphasis has been on discipleship... Discipling our student leaders and encouraging them to disciple others has been truly fruitful. Most of our freshmen students are being mentored and poured into by upperclassmen and staff with God sized results.

Nearly 30 students are planning on going with SLU BCM on our Mexico Mission trip December 14-19. We will be serving with LSU, LSUA, McNeese, Southern, and other BCMs in the state. Our students are excited to take the next step in their faith journey.

In addition to all this, BCM very much appreciates all the lunches our churches have provided over the past semester. We moved free lunch to Wednesdays this past August and we have been averaging between 160-180 students in attendance each week.

Leadership training is in full swing (16 students training as new leaders), Fuse worship has been extremely well attended, Spark Group (bible studies) are better attended this semester then I've seen in my time in ministry, and students hungry for the gospel are consistently meeting students that are willing to share the gospel with them.

But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. - Galatians 4:4-5

I was born with the name Donovan Donnelly. Following my parents' divorce, my mother did her best to raise me as a

single parent in the 1960s. I recall with fondness Mom's bedtime stories, the rich aroma of my grandfather (he liked cigars), my daycare center friends, and long, endless summers... I think I was a happy child. But then things got serious: I started the first grade. As you can see from the image of my "Social Characteristics" on the first-grade report card, I was easily distracted, impulsive, and quite talkative!

Supportive influences surrounded me. My mother and my grandfather were gentle, nurturing fixtures in my little world. Living in a mobile home park on the outskirts of San Antonio, Texas, I spent most of my time outside, running around with neighborhood buddies and creating a vast array of childhood "adventures." But deep down, I felt a little "different" from the other kids. I wasn't different. I just felt different.

Then my mother began dating a young Air Force pilot. I liked him. He was like a dad to me. Then they married... and my stepfather became my father: he <u>adopted</u> me as his son. My young mind easily embraced all the changes. My new name was Donovan Pucik. I really liked that. I didn't feel "different" anymore. I had a Dad <u>and</u> a Mom now.

- he chose to do it he chose me.


